

# Code of Conduct for all Exhibitors

Violations of the Code of Conduct may be subject to any or all of the following, as determined by Fair Management:

- a. Exhibitor may be asked to remove their exhibit(s)
- b. Exhibitor may have their premiums withheld
- c. Exhibitor may be subject to examination by a Disciplinary Committee
- d. Exhibitor may be banned from future fairs
- e. Exhibitor may face criminal charges

## **Respectable conduct is expected at all times**

1. Obscene language and roughhousing will not be tolerated at any time.
2. NO smoking will be permitted by exhibitors while showing, or taking part in any official activity of the Fair.
3. No Smoking or drinking of alcoholic beverages by minors as defined by State law will be allowed at any time and/or on any part of the fairgrounds.
4. The use or possession of firecrackers will be grounds for immediate suspension from the Fair.
5. Exhibitors will be held responsible for damage to any facilities or equipment.
6. Lariats, riding crops, etc. that are used to control animals will be used safely and appropriately.
7. Any person acting in an abusive manner toward people or animals will be immediately removed from the fair.
8. Exhibitors under 18 years of age must be chaperoned at all times by an adult over the age of 21.
9. Exhibitors under the age of 18 that stay overnight at the Fairgrounds in the RV Area must be chaperoned by an adult over the age of 24.
10. Exhibitors are not permitted to sell anything except auction entries. This includes all fundraising activities (food, drinks, newspaper/periodical subscriptions, etc.). Exhibitors can request permission from Fair Management for exceptions to this rule, please note that a vendor fee may be required.

## **Animals and other exhibits requiring care**

11. Exhibitors are responsible for their animals and any other exhibit requiring care (such as a garden installation). Fair Management is not responsible for providing food, water or supervision.
12. Exhibitors will keep animal areas clean at all times.
13. Exhibitors who are reported to the management for abuse or neglect of their animals will be brought before management for appropriate action.
14. Exhibitors will not be allowed in the "barns" from 10:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. unless authorized by fair staff.
