 - Market Goats: 11 a.m. – 12 p.m.
 - Lambs: 12:15 p.m. – 1:45 p.m.
 - Swine: 2 p.m. – 4 p.m.
 - Beef: 4:15 p.m. – 5:15 p.m.

Market animals not weighed-in by end time must go home, so be early!!!

Other Reminders

- **All Goat, Sheep, & Swine pens must be stripped on Thursday by 9:00 a.m.**
 - Market Beef stripped on Wednesday August 2nd by 9:00 a.m.
 - Dairy Cattle pens stripped on Thursday August 3rd by 9:00 a.m.
- **Small Animals**
 - Coop-in show: animals do not go home
 - Exhibitors need to feed and water everyday and check for heat exhaustion

Other Reminders #1

- **NO FOOD in Expo Hall or Gateway Hall**
- **Bottled water is OK**

Other Reminders #2

- **Cars off grounds by 9:00 a.m. and parked in designated parking lots**
 - You may drive on grounds to drop stuff off before 9:00 a.m.
 - **You will be towed if on grounds past 9:00 a.m.**
- **Barns will close 1 hour before fair closes everyday or one hour after completion of the last show**

Other Reminders #3

- All club/chapter meals need to be on the backside of Expo Hall or Gateway Hall
- There will be NO driving or parking on the back side of Expo Hall during Fair.
- One car per RV in RV areas. Cars will need to park along the fence line, not with RV
