

## Drug Statement

- Signature on entry form signifies compliance with all manufacturer and veterinarian pharmaceutical, biological and chemical instructions and withdrawal regulations, and that no off-label treatment or added hormones have been administered to any animal exhibited at the Santa Clara County Fair.
- All exhibitors shall advise management of any drugs and medications administered to an animal that might still be detected at the time of showing or at meat inspection. The name of the drug, its purpose, route, time and date of administration shall be presented to management prior to the showing or sale of the animal.
- Sellers are responsible for animals that are condemned or rejected at processing center. Seller may be liable to the buyer for an amount equal to three times the purchase price and may also be liable for attorney's fees and civil penalties (Food and Ag Code section 14363).

## Auction Statement

- If Exhibitor plans to sell an animal through the Youth Livestock Auction, the exhibitor must bring a completed Auction Entry Form to the Livestock Office by 9:30 p.m. on Thursday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. Auction forms can be picked up from the Livestock Office.
- No scratches or substitutions will be allowed.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to get the animal into the Auction Ring at the proper time – late animals will not be sold. Exhibitors will cooperate with Auction Committee by bringing their animals to the loading area, remaining with their animal at Auction Area and following directions on penning their animal when it leaves the Auction Area.
- Every attempt will be made to properly list all animals entered into the Auction. It is the seller's responsibility to check the Sale Order to verify their animal is listed. Copies of the Sale Order will be posted in the Barn and in the Livestock Office by 10:00 a.m., on Friday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The Livestock Office must be notified that an animal has been missed or of any miscellaneous errors by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017.  
It is the responsibility and obligation of the seller to thank their buyer promptly.
