Acceptable donations include non-perishable foods such meals in a can (stew, chili, soup), tuna/canned meat, peanut butter, low-sugar cereal, 100 percent fruit juices, canned fruit, canned vegetables and cans with pop-top lids. The organization asks to please avoid items packed in glass.
