**Pink Snouts, Curly Tails and Fast Legs
All-Alaskan Racing Pigs to Debut**

San Jose, CA— Pink snouts, curly tails and fast legs are barreling into the fairgrounds this year as the All-Alaskan Pig Races prepare to make their debut at the 2015 Santa Clara County Fair.

Visitors to the fair can witness these fast-paced piglets, four at a time, dash and jump through a hurdles course, but don't blink, they're quick. Each show is twenty minutes long and features four races.

What drives these piglets down the track is not only the glory of a win, but the cookies that are waiting behind the finish-line. Bart Koll, owner of All Alaskan Racing Pigs, admits that his eight piglets are a little spoiled. They live in an air-conditioned trailer, eat well and get their bedding changed twice daily. "They love what they do," Knoll said, "They like people and are fun to work with."

These famous piglets have appeared in hundreds of television news reports, over 500 news articles and performed at county and state fairs across the country.

Visitors can hoot, cheer and holler for these porcine speedsters every day of the fair in the Kid's Zone.
