Santa Clara County Fair Provides Free Kid's Admission Vouchers

San Jose, CA – Pig races, corndogs, jugglers and becoming a farmer for a day are a few activities students can enjoy with one of the free admission vouchers the Santa Clara County Fair provided to elementary schools across Santa Clara county this year.

“Our goal is to provide every elementary school child, grades K-6 in Santa Clara County with a free ticket to the fair,” explained Delana Romero, Executive Director of the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds.

“Last year, we provided over 40,000 admission vouchers to students” said Romero. “We are working toward our goal of increasing that number by providing every K-6th student in the county a free admission voucher to the 2016 Santa Clara County Fair.”

This year the Fair reached out to 14 school districts totaling 113 schools and 13 charter schools and plans to expand its ticket donations to more schools in the coming years. “One of the things we wanted to do this year was to give back to the community,” said Romero. “It made the most sense to do that right in our own backyard.”

Each ticket is redeemable for a single child admission to the Santa Clara County Fair when accompanied by a paying adult.

Four days of pure family fun is being planned for the first week in August at the Fairgrounds in San Jose so come celebrate the Santa Clara County Fair which will run August 4 - August 7, 2016. Information and discount tickets are available at TheFair.org
