CLASSES

Showmanship:

- Classes apply for Beef, Sheep, Swine, Goats and Dairy Cattle.
- Classes will be divided by the following age groups, based on your age as of January 1st, 2023.
 - PeeWee ages 5 to 8
 - Junior ages 9 to 12
 - Intermediate ages 13 to 15
 - Senior 16 to 19

Market Beef Cattle:

- Steers and Market Heifers will show together and will be broken into the following divisions:
 - Black/black cross
 - All other colors
 - British (Angus, Shorthorn, Hereford)
- Steer, Market Heifer, and Commercial Heifers classes will be broken by animal weight.

Market Sheep/Swine/Goats:

- Market classes will be divided by weight

Breeding Classes:

- Available for all species. Beef, Sheep, Swine, Goats and Dairy Cattle.
- All Registered Breeding classes will be divided by age.
- All Non-Registered/Grade Breeding classes will be divided by weight, with the exception of Dairy Cattle which is divided by age.

GENERAL RULES

Any exhibitor found to be violating any of the stated rules may face consequences under Show Management's discretion, which may lead to the exhibitor forfeiting all premiums, awards, and honors. Show Management has the final say and may interpret these rules as they see fit.

- There will be no refunds of entry money. NO exceptions whatsoever.
- The Stampede and Show Management reserves the right to change show classes, show order, stalling and show schedule at the time to improve the show.
- There will be a place to tie in cattle on a grass area. It is preferred that no bedding is used at tie-in area. You can bring pop up tents for shade.
- Exhibitors are expected to strip pens, clean up after their livestock, and themselves before departure. This includes but is not limited to bedding, manure, tack and other related items in stalls and fitting areas.
- Exhibitors must exhibit their own animals. If an exhibitor has two animals in the same class another exhibitor may show that other animal for them.
- Exhibitors must show their own animals entered under their name during showmanship.
- Any animal exhibiting signs of infection, disease, or any unsightly condition will not be permitted to show at The Stampede as determined by Show Management.
- Alcohol consumption on the grounds is prohibited for any exhibitor regardless of age.
- No dogs are permitted on the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds for this event.
- No intact males over 6 months of age are allowed on the grounds. Bull calves under 6 months of age, if part of a breeding group class, are allowed.
- All animals must be stalled in the locations designated by Show Management.
- Any animal deemed uncontrollable by Show Management will not be allowed to show and will be asked to leave the grounds.

Trailers

- There will be 6 spots available to show out of your trailer for \$50 a spot. First come first serve on Entries.
- Can accommodate trucks and trailers up to 50 feet in length
