



General Show Information and Rules

1. Any exhibitor found to be violating any of the stated rules may face consequences under Show Management's discretion, which may lead to the exhibitor forfeiting all premiums, awards, and honors. Show Management has the final say and may interpret these rules as they see fit.
2. There will be no refunds of entry money. NO exceptions whatsoever.
3. The Stampede and Show Management reserves the right to change show classes, show order, stalling and show schedule at the time to improve the show.
4. There will be a place to tie in cattle on a grass area. It is preferred that no bedding is used at tie-in area. You can bring pop up tents for shade.
5. Exhibitors are expected to strip pens, clean up after their livestock, and themselves before departure. This includes but is not limited to bedding, manure, tack and other related items in stalls and fitting areas.
6. Exhibitors must exhibit their own animals. If an exhibitor has two animals in the same class another exhibitor may show that other animal for them.
7. Exhibitors must show their own animals entered under their name during showmanship.
8. Any animal exhibiting signs of infection, disease, or any unsightly condition will be will not be permitted to show at The Stampede as determined by Show Management.
9. Alcohol consumption on the grounds is prohibited for any exhibitor regardless of age.
10. No dogs are permitted on the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds for this event.
11. Any animal deemed uncontrollable by Show Management will not be allowed to show and will be asked to leave the grounds.

Entry Information

1. Online entry due date is Friday June 6th, 2025.
2. Late entries will be accepted until Friday June 13th with an added late fee. Entries will not be accepted after June 13th.

 - a. Beef, Sheep, Swine, and Goat market and breeding entries: \$30 per entry

- i. Late Entry: \$50 per entry
 - b. Showmanship: \$10 per entry

Livestock Stalling In Barns

1. Complimentary shavings will not be provided by the fairgrounds. Exhibitors may bring and utilize their own shavings. Straw bedding will not be allowed.
2. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning their pens prior to departure. Please use the designated dump area.
3. There will be no pre-assigned stalls. Exhibitors may choose their own stalls on a first come-first served basis.
4. We kindly ask that you clean up your barn area including, bedding, trash, feed, and manure prior to your departure.

Show Out of Trailer Information

1. All livestock trailers that want to park in designated trailer spaces by the barn must purchase a “Show Out of Trailer” space online with your entries.
2. The cost is \$75, which provides (1) one show out of trailer space.
3. We kindly ask that you clean up your “show out of trailer” area including bedding, trash, feed and manure prior to your departure.

Showmanship

1. Showmanship ages will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2025.
2. Age Divisions will include
 - a. Pee Wee Showmanship
 - b. Junior Showmanship (Ages 9-12)
 - c. Intermediate Showmanship (Ages 13-15)
 - d. Senior Showmanship (Ages 16-19)
3. All exhibitors must show their own animal.
4. All animals shown in showmanship must also be entered in a market or breeding class.
5. Awards:
 - a. Division winners will be awarded a banner.

Swine Show Information

1. The Market Hog classes will include both barrows and gilts shown together. Gilts are eligible to be shown in both the market hog show and the breeding gilt show.
2. The Market Hog classes will be broken by weight.

3. Breeding Gilt classes will be broken into the following divisions:
 - a. Dark AOB- Dark Colored Purebred Hogs: Hampshire, Duroc, Berkshire, etc.
 - b. Light AOB- Light Colored Purebred Hogs: Yorkshire, Landrace, etc.
 - c. Crossbred- Gilts not representing breed standards: Blue Roan, Blue Butts, Calico, etc.
4. Awards:
 - a. Breeding division champions and overall champions will be awarded a banner.
 - b. Market Champions will receive a buckle and banner.

Sheep Show Information

1. The Market Sheep classes will be broken by weight.
2. Wether Dam Ewes can be dual entered in the market show/ wether dam ewe show.
3. The Wether Dam Ewe show will be broken into the following divisions:
 - a. Speck/Whiteface
 - b. Natural
 - c. Blackface
4. Awards:
 - a. Breeding division champions and overall champions will be awarded a banner.
 - b. Market Champions will receive a buckle and banner.

Goat Show Information

1. The Market Goat classes will be broken by weight.
2. Wether Dam Does can be dual entered in the market show/ wether dam doe show.
